MASON & SAN SABA – Receipts totaled 1024 head. Comparing the market to two weeks ago due to the no sale during the Thanksgiving week the stocker steers and heifers sold \$5 lower. The feeder steers were \$3 lower and feeder heifers were \$5 lower. The futures board has been very volatile over the last several weeks with some days limit up and other days limit down due to the extra beef in cold storage from the overweight fat cattle and the stronger dollar that has lowered our exports. Hopefully over the next month we can get more current on the supply side and indications are the trend is moving in that direction. The packer cows, bulls and replacement cattle all sold steady.
