The quality and the buyer activity was good with the stocker steers selling fully steady with a set of 24 steers at 524 lbs \$203.00 (\$1063.72) and heifers were steady also. Feeder steers and heifers were fully steady with a deal of 25 steers 604 lbs \$184.00 (\$1111.36). Packer cows and bulls were steady with the highest bull at \$108.00 and top cow at \$88.00. Pairs and bred cows were steady. The 12th Annual Cattleman's Kind 65 head of Black Simmental and SimAngus bulls (13-18 months old) averaged \$3670.00 with the top bull bringing \$5600.00.
