SAN SABA – Receipts totaled 1,025 head with no sale being held at Mason due to the Easter Holiday. The futures market had been up and down at the end of last week and beginning of this week but moved much higher Wednesday and Thursday so we saw stocker steers sell \$5 higher and stocker heifers \$5 to \$7 higher with 7 steers at 582 lbs \$173.00 (\$1,066.86). The feeder steers were \$5 higher with 7 steers at 660 lbs \$164.00 (\$1,082.40) and feeder heifers were \$3-\$5 higher. Packer cows were \$3-\$5 higher and bulls were \$5 higher with the top bull at \$96.50. Pairs and bred cows were steady. The Knox Brothers coming 2 year old Hereford bulls avg. \$2,533, 18 months avg. \$2563, and the 35 yearlings avg. \$2793 with the top Hereford bull at \$3,800. The Knox Brothers 29 yearling Angus bulls avg. \$2,312 with the top bull at \$2,800.
