## **Early Spring Replacement Female Sale Saturday, February 23 @ 10:00 a.m. – San Saba**

Bred Cows, Pairs, Bred and Open Heifers will be offered

- **30** Choice first calf Brangus pair that will have calves at their side that will weigh 250-300 lbs. Pairs have been running on wheat and are in good shape. They have been left open for the bull of your choice. They will be the calf raising kind. (1)
- **5** First calf Angus pair that will have Angus calves at their side. Heifers have been left open for the bull of your choice. Pairs will have matching ear tags. If you are looking for a uniform set then take a look at these. (2)

**20** Choice Chocolate True F-1 heifers that will be long bred to Red and Black Angus bulls. Heifers will weigh 1100 lbs plus. This will be a front pasture kind. (3)

- **6** Home raised Brahman heifers that are out of Hudgins bulls. Heifers are open and will weigh 800 lbs. They are 18-20 months old, have no brands or earmarks. Heifers will come to feed and be ready for the bull of your choice this spring. (4)
- **35** Home raised Brangus heifers that are out of registered Brangus bull and registered or commercial Brangus cows. No papers will be furnished. Heifers will weigh 700 lbs and will be ocv. They will be ideal for the bulls this spring. (5)

**20** Super Black Baldie heifers that are long bred to Red Angus bulls. Heifers have a lot of age and will weigh 1050-1150 lbs. Heifers are gentle and come to a feed wagon and will make someone a choice set of front pasture cows. (6)

- **3** Registered polled Hereford heifers that will range from 12-15 months old. Heifers are out of Norman Grenwelve cows and Boyd Bellringer bull. They are very gentle and are current on all shots. Paper will be available on sale day. (7)
- **12** Choice first calf Brangus pair that will have Brangus calves at their side that are six weeks old. Cows have been left open for the bull of your choice. (8)

- **15** One raising set of Black F-1 pair that will have Hereford calves at their side. Cows are 7 years old and have been running back with a Hereford bull and some could be 3in1's. (26)
- **5** Second calf Brangus pair that have Angus or Charolais calves at their side. Cows will be gentle and come to feed. (27)
- **5** Angus or Charolais cross heifers that will be long bred to an Angus or Charolais bull. Heifers will weigh 1000 lbs and be sorted into uniform groups. (28)
- **18** Open Angus heifers that will be weighing 700 lbs and will be ready for the bulls this spring. They are all one raising and will be ocv. (30)
- **7** Home raised Angus heifers that are out of a Bradley Angus bull and are 13 months old. Heifers are ocv and will weigh 800 lbs. They have had two rounds of shots and will be gentle. (31)
- **40** Black & black white face cows that are 3-5 years old bred to black bulls. These females are all long bred and could have some pairs by sale day. (32)
- **2** Black white face cows that are 5-6 years old and long bred to Angus and Charolais bulls. They could be pairs by sale day. (33)
- **8** Red motley face heifers long bred to a low birth weight bull. (34)
- **18** Young Angus along with a few black baldie cows that will be long bred to Hogue Ranch Angus bulls. Cows are all raised on the ranch and will be five or younger. Baldies will be sold separate from the Angus. (35)
- **14** Brangus heifers that will be long bred to easy calving solid Black Wagyu bulls. They are gentle and come to feed. (36)
- **40** Young Brangus cows that will be long bred to Angus bulls. Cows are in good flesh and all come to feed. Could be a few calves by sale day. Most cows will be five years or younger. (37)
- **39** Angus and black baldie cows along with a few red baldies that will be long bred to Langford Ranch Hereford bulls. Cows will be baby tooth up to solid mouth. They will be sorted according to age, pregnancy and kind. (38)
- **5** Angus heifers that will be long bred to a Braford bull and there will be a few calves on the ground sale day. Heifers will weigh 1000 lbs and will be super gentle and the calf raising kind. Heifers are cake broke. (39)
- **5** Brangus heifers that will be long bred to a low birth weight Brangus bull and there will be a few calves on the ground by sale day. They will come to feed and be gentle. (40)
- **4** Black motley face first calf pair with calves out of a Corriente bull. Heifers have been left open for the bull of your choice. They are gentle and will come to feed. (41)

- **2** F-1 heifers that will be selling as long bred to a Knox Brothers low birth weight Angus bull. Heifers are home raised and gentle. (42)
- **5** Open heifers with 3 being Angus plus and 2 Brangus heifers that will average 700 lbs. Heifers are all ocv and current on all shots. (43)
- **3** Home raised certified Black True F-1 heifers out of a Heart Bar Brahman bull and Angus cows. Heifers will weigh 750-800 lbs and have had all their shots and wormed. They will come to feed and are ocv. (44)
- **12** Brangus heifers that are selling as open. They will weigh 850 lbs and will be ready for the bull of your choice. Heifers are ocv and have been running on wheat and will be in great shape. (45)
- **15** Brangus and Brangus Built cows that are 3-6 years old and long bred to registered Brangus bulls. This is a nice set of young gentle cows. (46)
- **14** Brangus and Brangus Built cows that are 3-6 years old short bred to a registered Brangus bull. These cattle come to feed and are gentle. (47)
- **10** First calf Brangus Built pair with Ultra Built calves at their side. Pairs have been left open to breed to the bull of your choice. (48)
- **50** Outstanding 5-6 year old Tigerstripe pair. This is a one raising set of females all carrying one brand and a year brand and raised out of Hereford cows and registered Brahman bulls. - **10** First calf Angus plus pair that have a choice set of Angus calves at their side. They will be selling back as open for the bull of your choice. They are gentle and will come to feed. (56)
- **4** Choice black white face heifers out of Hereford cows and an Angus bull. Heifers are bred to a low birth weight Angus bull to start calving in March. Females will weigh 1000 lbs and are gentle and cake broke.(57)
- **60** Open Brangus heifers weighing 700 lbs. These heifers have been vaccinated and wormed recently. Females are all home raised. (58)

- **30** Gray Brahman cows coming 8 years old. This set of females are long bred to Gray Brahman & Hereford bulls. Cows are in great flesh & gentle. (61)
- **22** Choice F-1 Tigerstripe heifers long bred to proven registered low birth weight Angus bulls. These females are gentle, come to feed and are all ocv. Heifers have been recently wormed. (62)
- **5** Angus and black white face pair that have Angus cross calves at their side that will average 375 lbs, Cows are running back with a Beefmaster bull and should be 3in1's on sale day. Cows are 3-6 years old and gentle.
- **3** Angus cows that are 3-6 years old that will be selling as medium bred to a Beefmaster bull. (63)
- **95** Angus or Angus plus cows that will be short to medium bred to Angus or Charolais bulls. They will be 6-8 years old and sorted into uniform groups according to kind. (64)
- **4** Crossbred cows that will be coming up with their second calf out of Charolais or Angus bulls. They are gentle and come to feed. (65)
- **5** Big choice Brangus heifers that will be long bred to a polled Hereford bull. Heifers will weigh 1050 lbs. Good gentle set of heifers. (66)
- **2** Third calf Angus plus pair with Angus plus sired calves at their side. Calves are young and you can breed them back to the bull of your choice. (67)
- **18** Angus and black baldie (English) pair that have Angus calves at their side that will weigh 200-400 lbs and have been running back with Angus bulls. Several will be 3in1 packages. Of the group 3 are baldies with the balance being Angus. Baldies will sell separately. These pair will be 6 years or younger and will have matching eartags. (68)
- **2** Charolais pair with Angus sired calves at their side and running back with Angus bulls. Should be 3in1's on sale day. Good set of baby tooth up to 6 year old cows. (69)

- 2 Brangus cows short bred to a Brahman bull. Cows are 5-6 years old. (70)
- 47 Fancy Hereford heifers long bred to low birth weight Clark Angus bulls. This set of females are big, stout and super gentle. These are front pasture females! (71)
- 3 Home raised Angus heifers out of a registered Angus bull (Sub Zero). Heifers are weighing 800 lbs and will be ocv. (72)
- 6 Home raised Angus/Charolais cross heifers that will be selling as open. Heifers are out of a registered Charolais bull that goes back to Nitt Charolais in Oklahoma. They will weigh 800 lbs and have no brands or ear marks. They are ready for the bull of your choice. (73)
- 4 Open Angus and black white face heifers that will average 750 lbs. Heifers are gentle and will be ideal for the bull of your choice this spring. (74)
- 5 Hereford pair that will have True F-1 calves at their side. Cows have been exposed to a Brahman bull. They are 5 years old and will come to feed. Pairs will be selling back as exposed. (75)
- 5 Hereford pair that will have Angus sired calves at their side that will weigh 250-300 lbs. Cows are 5 years old and have been running back with a Brahman bull and should be 3in1's. Pairs are gentle and will come to feed. (76)
- 40 Red Angus pair that have their third calf at their side out of Valnes Ranch Red Angus bulls and have been running back with the same bulls with some being 3in1's by sale day. Pairs all come to feed. They will be sorted up in uniform groups. (77)
- 8 First calf Angus pair with 300 lbs calves at their side. Pairs are all one raising. There are 4 bull calves and 4 heifer calves at their side that are out of a Gardiner Objective son. They are gentle and easy to keep and have not had a bull back with them so that you can breed them back to the bull of your choice. (78)
- 45 Brangus pair with calves at their side out of Hereford bulls. Cows are 5 years old. (81)
- 40 Angus pair that are 3-5 years old with Black F-1 calves at their side. Calves are sired by registered Gray Brahman bulls and cows are open to breed to the bull of your choice. (83)
- 87 Angus cows that are 3-5 years old and long bred to registered Gray Brahman bulls. This will be a nice set of young Angus cows that will raise a valuable set of calves. (84)
- 7 Angus heifers that are selling as long bred to a registered low birth weight Angus bull. Heifers are weighing 1100 lbs and they are out of registered stock. Heifers will be gentle and come to feed. They are home raised. (85)
- 20 Angus Corriente cross cows that are 3-4 years old bred to Black Corriente bulls. (86)
- 20 Brangus cows bred to Angus bulls. Cows are 7 years old. (87)
- 4 First calf Brangus pair with calves at their side out of a Brangus bull. Cows are left open so you can breed them back to the bull of your choice. (88)
- 2 Open Angus plus heifers weighing 750 lbs. (89)
- 7 Black & black white face cows long bred to an Angus bull. Several will be pairs by sale day. Cows are all second and third calf. (90)
- 7 Angus plus cows with one calf on the ground out of a registered polled Santa Gertrudis bull with the balance being long bred to the same bull. (91)
