- **5** First calf Red Brangus pair that will have Hereford calves at their side and cows have been running back with an Angus bull (OCC Legend grandson). They could be 3in1's and they are all current on all shots. Don't see many of these! (8)

Cows were exposed for a short time to Clark Ranch bulls and have been running back with Hudgins Gray Brahman bulls for the past 45 days. Bull calves have been worked and calves have matching eartags. These will make a super F-1 factory. (10)
- 45** Choice Hereford heifers long bred to low birth weight Clark Angus bulls. These are a big stout set of Herefords that will make a nice set of cows. (11)
- 30** Choice Hereford heifers that are medium bred to low birth weight Clark Angus bulls. Great set of fall calving females that will last you a lifetime. (12)
- 100** Fancy Hereford heifers exposed to low birth weight Clark Angus bulls for 45 days. This set of females are approximately 18 months old and are big and stout. Heifers will be sorted into uniform groups. (13)

- **100** Angus, black baldie along with a few red baldie cows (some having a touch of ear) that will be coming up with their second calf this fall out of Langford Hereford and 44 Farms Angus bulls. - **17** True F-1 Tigerstripe heifers that will weigh 750 lbs and selling as open. Heifers are ocv and current on shots. They will be sorted into uniform groups. (18)
- **6** Open Brahman heifers that will weigh 750 lbs and be ocv. Heifers are dehorned and current on shots. (19)
- **32** Purebred Gray Brahman heifers that will average 750-800 lbs. Heifers are all ocv and will be ideal for the bull of your choice. Heifers have been handled the right way. Don's miss on this set of productive females. (20)

- **105** Angus plus cows which 35 will have calves at their side out of Angus bulls and 70 will be medium to long bred to Angus bulls. Cows are 4 years old. They will be sorted into uniform groups according to kind. (38)
- **85** Angus and black baldie pair that will have Angus and Charolais calves at their side and have been running back with the same bull. This is a good set of solid mouth (some 4-5 years old) and will be sorted and shaped into uniform groups according to age, kind and pregnancy. (39)
- **17** Home raised Brangus heifers that will be selling as open. Heifers will weigh 750 lbs and be ocv. They are current on all shots. (40)
- **40** Choice super baldie heifers which 20 will have calves at their side and 20 will be long bred to solid Black Corriente bulls and are easy calving. These heifers are very gentle and will come to feed. Don's miss this set of good of calf raisers. Pairs will have matching eartags. (41)
- **30** Black and black baldie cows (some with a touch of ear) that will calve this fall out of Langford Ranch Hereford bulls. Calves were just weaned off this solid mouth set of cows. (42)

- **35** Home raised open Brangus heifers with a few being Brangus white face heifers that will average 900 lbs. Heifers are all ocv and will be ready for the bull of your choice. They are gentle and will come to feed. Don't miss this set of long aged heifers that will make a productive set of cows. (43)

- **9** Beefmaster cows in which 6 will be pairs and 3 will be bred to a son of Fusion or a Foundation bull off the Lasater herd. Cows will be solid red in color and will be 7 years old. They are very gentle and will be sorted into uniform groups. (48)
- **6** Open Beefmaster heifers that are solid red and are one raising. (49)
- **30** Black and black white face cows 4-5 years old. This one raising set of females are fall calving and are bred to registered Angus bulls to calve for a 90 day calving period. Cows are in excellent condition. (50)
- **20** First calf Angus and black white face pair with Angus sired calves at their side up to two months old. Cows are selling as open and calves will have matching eartags. (51)
- **9** Black white face heifers bred to calve in the fall to low birth weight Angus bull. Heifers are all ocv and gentle. (52)
- **2** Red Angus pair that are three years old with Red Angus sired calves at their side and exposed back to a Red Angus bull. (53)
- **1** Red white face pair that is 3 years old with a Red Angus sired calf at its side and exposed back to a Red Angus bull. (54)
- **1** Hereford pair with a Red Angus sired calf at its side and exposed back to a Red Angus bull. This cow is 5 years old. (55)
- **41** Angus and Angus plus cows 3-5 years old that are 5-7 months bred to Angus bulls. (56)
- **60** Open Tigerstripe heifers that will average 675 lbs. Heifers are current on all shots and are ocv. Heifers will be ready for the bulls of your choice. They have been handled the right way and are easy to work. Don't miss this set of productive heifers. (57)
- **20** Open Gray Brahman heifers that will average 650-750 lbs. Heifers are all ocv and current on shots. They are gentle and have been handled the right way. (58)
- **20** Black and black white face heifers with a few Charolais cross heifers that will be selling as medium to long bred to black bulls. (59)
- **10** Angus and black baldie heifers that will be calving this fall out of low birth weight Angus bulls. Heifers are all one raising. Baldies will sell separate from the blacks. (60)

- **11** Bred heifers two years old that will be medium to long bred to low birth weight Red Angus bulls. There will be 6 black baldie (Angus Hereford cross) and 5 red baldie (Red Angus Hereford cross). All are home grown on the ranch. (63)
- **14** Red Brahman cross pair that are 5-7 years old with a choice set of red white face calves at their side that are out of registered Hereford bulls. Cows are running back with same bulls and could be 3in1's by sale day. Cows are gentle and will come to feed. (64)
- **8** Red Brahman cross cows that are 5-7 years old that will be selling as medium to long bred to a registered Hereford bull. Cows are gentle and easy to handle. (65)
- **2** Red Angus cows that are 5-7 years old that will be selling as medium to long bred to a registered Red Angus bull. Cows are very gentle and will come to feed. (66)
- **15** Choice open Brangus heifers that are all one raising. They will be tagged with Brangus Built eartags and will not be carrying any brands or earmarks. They are all ocv and will come to feed. Heifers are coming from the Connie & AD McKinnerney Ranch. (67)
