Bred Cows, Pairs, Bred and Open Heifers will be offered

- **18** Red Angus/Hereford cross cows that are four years old and bred to Red Angus bulls to start calving September. This is a choice set of females. (1)
- **25** Choice Angus and black white face heifers that will calve this fall starting in September to proven low birth weight Angus bulls. Heifers will weigh 1000-1100 lbs. All one raising, gentle and come to feed. (2)
- **25** Choice black baldie heifers that start calving in September for 90 days out of 44 Farms Ranch low birth weight Angus bulls. Heifers are all one raising out of Flying S Hereford cows and 44 Farms Ranch Angus bulls. Good gentle set of heifers. For pictures go to our website. (3)
- **14** Red Angus/Hereford (red baldie) cross cows that have 9 calves at their side with the balance being fall calving. Cows were all bred to Red Angus bulls and are 3-4 years old. They are very gentle and come to feed. Very easy fleshing set of cows. Pairs will sell separately from the breds. (4)
- **24** Choice Angus heifers that will weigh 1100-1150 lbs and will be long bred to low birth weight Larry Donop Ranch Angus bulls. Heifers should calve in August, September and October. Good big set of fall calvers. (5)
- **10** Angus pair that will be second and third calf and have been running back with Angus bulls and should be 3in1's by sale day. (6)
- **40** One raising set of Brangus heifers that are 30 months old and will be selling as long bred to proven low birth weight Brangus bulls. Heifers are home raised and very gentle. Don't miss out on this set of productive heifers that will last a life time. (7)
- **20** Straight four year old Angus pair with Hereford cross calves at their side that will average 300 lbs. Cows are running back with the same bull and should be 3in1's on sale day. (8)
- **14** Fancy open Tigerstripe heifers out of registered Hereford cows and V8 Brahman bulls. Heifers will weigh 650 lbs, ocv and dehorned. This gentle set of heifers are nice. (9)
- **3** Charolais heifers bred to low birth weight Angus bull. These females all go back to Hoo Doo Ranch Charolais cows from Cody, WY. Heifers will calve this fall. (10)
- **40** Open Tigerstripe heifers weighing 750 lbs. These females are all ocv and clean headed. They will make a nice set of females. (11)
- **15** Open Brangus baldie heifers weighing 700 lbs. These heifers are all ocv and gentle. (12)
- **51** Brangus & Angus plus cows that will be 4-5 years old and bred to Hereford bulls to calve November through January. This is a good set of winter calving cows. (13)
- **6** Angus pair with calves at their side out of Angus and SimAngus bulls and have been running back with the same bulls. One is a fourth calf cow and four are fifth calf cows. All have matching eartags. (14)

70 Choice black baldie (1/8 Brahman) one raising set weighing 600 lbs and were raised out of Jorgenson Ranch Angus bulls and Braford cows. Heifers will not be carrying any brands, all ocv and have had IBR shots. This group will make someone a productive set of momma cows. Heifers are coming from a reputation herd, the McFadden Ranch. For videos of these heifers please go to our website. This kind of heifers are hard to find. (15)

- **20** Angus and black baldie cows that are 3-5 years old bred for fall calving to Angus bulls. They are gentle and come to feed. Baldies will sell separately from the Angus. (16)
- **3** Angus pair that are 3 years old with Angus calves at their side and running back with an Angus bull. (17)
- **10** Hereford heifers that go back to Barber Ranch Hereford bloodlines. Heifers have been with ½ Angus ½ Corriente bulls for approximately 90 days. They are current on all vaccinations and weighing 700-750 lbs. Very gentle. (18)
- **10** Open Hereford heifers in which 5 are polled and 5 are horned (but are clean headed). They are all ocv and will weigh 750-800 lbs. (19)
- **20** Brangus cows 3-5 years old bred to calve this fall out of Brangus bulls. Cows are in good flesh. (20)
- **10** Home raised red motley face heifers that are out of Gert cows and Hereford bulls that will average 950 lbs. Heifers will calve this fall out of Angus bulls. Year branded. (21)

- **10** Home raised three year old black and red cows that are out of Tigerstripe cows and Limousin bulls. Cows are year branded, average 950 lbs and will calve this fall out of Angus bulls. (22)
- **10** Second calf black and red cows that are out of Gert cows and Limousin bulls. Cows are home raised, year branded and will average 950 lbs. They are selling as medium to long bred to a Hereford bull. (23)
- **4** Registered open polled Hereford heifers that will average 800 lbs. Heifers are all Norman Crenwelge bloodlines. They are very gentle and will be ideal for the bull of your choice this fall. Heifers are very gentle and will come to feed. (24)
- **75** Open handpicked Tigerstripe heifers that will average 675 lbs. Heifers will be ideal for the bull of your choice this fall. Heifers are all ocv and current on all shots. They are gentle and have been handled the right way. (25)
- **50** One raising set of Brangus and Ultra Black heifers. Heifers will be selling as long bred to Mound Creek low birth weight Brangus bulls. They are very gentle and the right kind. Don't miss out on this set of home raised heifers that will fit any program. (26)
- **45** Young Angus along with a few baldies that will have approximately 20 calves at their side out of Angus bulls with the balance being fall calving bred to Angus bulls. The pairs have been running back with Angus bulls. Cows are mostly all second calf and will be sorted into uniform groups according to pairs and bred cows. (27)
- **90** Hereford pair that are all one raising with Hereford sired calves at their side and have been running back with Hereford bulls. There will be a good many 3in1's. Pairs are 7 years old and are all raised on this ranch as heifer calves. They will be sorted and shaped into uniform groups. Ranch sold is the reason for the pairs to be at this sale. (28)
- **3** Hereford pair that have their second calf at their side and have been running back with Hereford bulls and should be 3in1's. Good young set of Hereford pair. (29)
- **15** Angus and Angus plus cows that will be medium bred to a real good Black SimAngus bull. Cows will be solid mouth and come to feed. (30)
- **25** Angus cows that will be fall calving out of choice Angus bulls. Cows will be solid mouth. (31)
- **7** Four year old Angus cows that have 5 calves at their side with the balance being medium to long bred to Angus bulls. (32)
- **43** Santa Gertrudis cows with approximately 1/2 with calves at their side and the balance being fall calving cows that are all bred to Hereford bulls and pairs have been running back with Hereford bulls. This set will be 5-6 years old and sorted into uniform groups according to pairs, bred etc. (33)
- **45** Angus plus pair with calves at their side out of Hereford bulls and have been running back with Hereford bulls with several being 3in1's. Pairs will be 5-6 years old and shaped into uniform groups. (34)
- **10** One raising set of polled Hereford heifers bred to low birth weight Angus bulls to start calving in September. (35)
- **10** Open Angus heifers weighing 650 lbs. This is a one raising set of females. (36)
- **2** Charolais/Angus cross pair that are baby tooth with big calves at their side and should be 3in1's by sale day. (37)
- **49** Angus cows that will calve this fall (September through November) out of Powell Ranch Angus bulls. This is a good set of solid mouth cows. (38)
- **12** Bred heifers that consist of 8 Brangus and 4 Tigerstripe that will be selling as short to medium bred to registered low birth Angus bulls. Heifers are gentle and easy to handle. (39)
- **3** Open Angus heifers that are 16 months old and will average 750 lbs. Heifers have been wormed and are current on all shots. They are gentle and easy to handle. (40)
- **30** Angus or Brangus type cows with some baldies that will be medium to long bred to Angus bulls. Cows will be 4-6 years old and will be sorted into uniform groups according to kind and pregnancy. (41)
- **15** Red or Charolais cross cows that will be medium to long bred to an Angus bull. Cows are 4-6 years old and will be sorted into uniform groups. (42)
- **18** Angus plus pair that have Angus calves at their side. Cows are selling back as open for the bull of your choice. They are gentle and solid mouth. (43)
- **9** Open heifers weighing around 800 lbs, ocv and current on their vaccinations. Five will be Angus type and 4 Brangus cross. (44)
- **22** Solid mouth Angus cows bred to start calving September 1st to 44 Farms registered Angus bulls. (45)
- **50** Hereford cows that will calve this fall out of Hereford bulls. (start calving September 20) Thirty of these cows will be 3-6 years old with the balance being solid mouth. Cows were raised and are coming from the well known Coates Hereford Ranch. They will be sorted and shaped according to age. Cows were all dehorned as heifer calves. (46)
- **20** Fancy open heifers in which 16 will be fancy black baldies and 4 Brangus. Heifers are all ocv and will be weighing 750-800 lbs. Heifers have a lot of eye appeal. (47)
- **25** Purebred Charolais cows that will have Charolais sired calves at their side that will weigh 450-500 lbs. Cows are 3-6 years old with a few older cows. They have been running with a choice Charolais bull and should be 3in1's. They have raised bulls out of this set of cows for the past several years. Cows are very gentle and will follow you anywhere. (48)

- **25** Brangus pair that will have Charolais cross calves at their side that will weigh 400-500 lbs. Cows are straight 6 years old and the calf raising kind. They have been running back with Charolais bulls and should be 3in1's. Cows are very gentle and will come to feed. (49)
- **3** Angus pair that will have Angus calves at their side and the cows have been running back with the same Angus bull and could be 3in1's. Cows are 7 years old and will be gentle and in good shape. (50)
- **3** Angus cows that will be bred to an Angus bull to calve this fall. Cows are 7 years old. They will be gentle and in good shape. (51)
- **7** Hereford heifers that are one raising bred to calve in the middle of December for 60 days to a proven easy calving Red Angus bull. Heifers are all dehorned. They have a gentle disposition and are home raised. All heifers are on an excellent vaccination program and will be 2 past when they calve. (52)
- **8** Black baldie (Hereford/Angus cross) heifers that are one raising bred to calve the middle of December for 60 days to a proven easy calving Red Angus bull. Gentle and come to feed. Heifers are on a good vaccination program.(53)
- **8** Black baldie (Hereford/Angus cross) heifers that will be open. One raising, gentle, come to feed and current on all vaccinations. (54)
- **26** Angus cows that will be bred to Angus bulls. Twenty will calve this fall and winter and six will calve early spring. They are gentle and come to feed. Will sort into uniform groups. (55)
- **7** Open Angus heifers that are 18-19 months old and will weigh 850 lbs. Current on all shots and one raising. (56)
- **10** Open home raised Angus heifers out of 44 Farms Angus cows and registered Angus bulls. All are ocv and gentle. (57)
- **25** Angus cows that will be early fall calving bred to Angus bulls that go back to Gardiner bloodlines. All are home raised. They will be mixed ages (young to solid mouth) and sorted into uniform groups. Cows are being sold because the ranch they are on is selling. (58)
- **20** Red Angus and Black Angus pair with Red Angus sired bull calves at their side weighing 150-300 lbs. Some will sell as 3in1's. Pairs will have either their third or fourth calf at their side. 15 will be Red Angus pair and 5 will be Black Angus pair. (59)
- **10** Open one raising spring calving Black Maine/Angus cross heifers that were AI'd the first of June to a Pendleton low birth weight Angus bull. Heifers weigh around 750-800 lbs. They will make a good set of momma cows. (60)
- **76** Black and black white face heifers short to medium bred to low birth weight Angus bulls from Domel's Double Creek Farm. Heifers have had two rounds of shots, trich vaccine and wormed. Females are all home raised, all fire number branded and have matching number eartags. These will be a nice set of females that will last a lifetime. Heifers will average 1050 lbs. (61)
- **70** Black and black white face heifers exposed to low birth weight Angus bulls from Double Creek Farms in Clifton. Females have had two rounds of shots, trich vaccine and wormed. Heifers are all fire branded and have matching number eartags. These heifers are all home raised and will weigh 900 lbs. Exposed since June 22, 2018. (62)
- **7** Open black & black white face heifers weighing 725 lbs. They have had two rounds of shots, trich vaccine and fire number branded and number tagged to match. (63)
- **17** Super baldie heifers short to medium bred to Double Creek low birth weight Angus bulls. Heifers will be sorted for pregnancy. (64)
- **60** Angus and Angus baldie cows 3-8 years old. Cows have been with registered Angus bulls from February 20 to June 1. Cows will be sorted by age and pregnancy. (65)
- **2** Red baldie pair with their first calf at their side out of Angus bulls. These females have been running back with a Charolais bull and could be 3in1's by sale day. These are big and stout. (66)
- **11** Exposed Tigerstripe heifers weighing 700 lbs. These females are ocv, clean headed and exposed to a low birth weight Angus bull for 60 days. (67)
- **4** Charolais cross pair that are middle aged and selling back as open. (68)
- **2** Black pair that are middle aged and selling back as open. (69)
- **4** Horned Hereford pair with Angus sired calves at their side. Cows are 5 years old and are open. (70)
- **4** Horned Hereford cows medium to long bred to Angus bulls. Cows are 5 years old. (71)
