45 Fancy one raising set of True Black F-1 heifers that are out of Angus cows and Hudgins Brahman bulls. They are all ocv and not carrying any brands or earmarks. Heifers will weigh around 650-675 lbs. (1)

- **12** Fancy Red Angus cows that are one raising and will be long bred to an Angus bull. Cows are 3-4 years old and carrying one brand. They will come to feed and be gentle. (2)

23 One raising set of fancy Tigerstripe heifers that are coming off the Schenkel Ranch in Sonora. Heifers will be selling as medium to long bred to low birth weight Angus bulls. These heifers are gentle and easy to handle. Don't miss this set of heifers that have topped our sale for many years. (3)

55 One raising set of open black white face heifers that are out of Tigerstripe cows and 44 Farms Angus bulls. Heifers will average 700 lbs and will be ideal for the bulls of your choice this fall. Heifer are easy to handle and will make a productive set of cows. (4)

- **49** Home raised Angus heifers bred to start calving September 1 to low birth weight registered Haverlah Angus bulls. These females are all ocv and gentle and come to feed. (5)

11 Fancy open True F-1 heifers that are one raising out of Scott Rushing registered Gray Brahman bulls and purebred Hereford cows. Heifers are not carrying any brands or earmarks and will weigh 700-750 lbs on sale day. They received 2 doses of Vision 7 and Lepto Vibro and were poured on with Ivomec. Heifers are very, very gentle and will eat cubes out of the owner's hand and can be easily worked on an ATV. Heifers are coming from the reputation Mike Huddleston Ranch. - **30** Angus cows that will be long bred to Hereford bulls. Cows are third calf and will be in great shape. They will come to feed and will follow you anywhere. A good set of young Angus cows. For pictures go to our website. (12)

80 Red Angus cross heifers that are all one raising and will start calving in January out of proven low birth weight EPD Red Angus bulls (with most going back to Ludvigson Red Angus Ranch bloodlines). Bulls were turned out April 1 to July 1 for a 90 day calving period. These heifers are all ½ to ¾ Red Angus out of Beefmaster or Red Angus/Beefmaster cross cows. These are the top set of heifers kept on the ranch. Heifers were born in the spring of 2017. These will make a good set of ranch cows. Not many of these around. For pictures go to our website. (13)

12 Choice True F-1 heifers that are all one raising (go back to Rex Glover bloodlines) and have been running with low birth weight Angus bulls since July. Heifers will come to feed and are a long aged set of heifers. Folks that have had the heifers before have been very pleased with them as momma cows. For pictures go to our website. (14)

- **12** Angus plus heifers that are all one raising and will calve this fall out of low birth weight Angus bulls. Heifers are not carrying any brands or earmarks. Heifers all go back to Gordon Sauer Ranch Angus+ bloodlines. They are gentle and will come to feed. For pictures go to our website. (15)
- **175** Angus or black white face cows that will be long bred to Hereford bulls. Cows are 3-5 years old and will be sorted into uniform groups according to kind. (16)
- **25** Red Angus cows that will be long bred to a Hereford bull. Cows are 3-5 years old. (17)
- **37** Choice home raised English baldie heifers that are out of Angus cows and Hereford bulls. Heifers will weigh 750 lbs and will be ocv. They are gentle and ready for the bull of your choice. (18)
- **25** Home raised Red Angus heifers that will weigh 750 lbs and are ready for the bulls of your choice. Heifers will be ocv and make a super set of momma cows. (19)
- **27** Angus cows with a few baldies that will be long bred to Angus bulls. Cows are 3-5 years old and will be sorted into uniform groups according to kind. All cows will come to feed and are easy to handle. They are a good set of calf raisers. (20)

- **35** Angus heifers that will be medium bred to low birth weight Angus bulls. Heifers are all ocv, gentle and come to feed. (24)
- **10** Black & black white face pair that have Angus calves at their side and will be selling back as open for the bull of your choice. Cows are mostly first and second calf and are very gentle.
- **25** Angus and black white face pair that are 3-5 years old that have Angus or Charolais cross calves at their side. Cows are exposed back to Angus or Charolais bulls. Cows will come to feed and are easy to handle. (25)
- **3** Angus pair that will have an Angus sired calves at their side. Cows are 7 years old and have been exposed to an Angus bull. (26)
- **8** SimAngus cows that will be long bred to an Angus bull. Cows are 6 years old. They will be gentle and come to feed. (27)
- **9** Charolais cross cows that will be long bred to an Angus bull. Cows are 4-5 years old and are a one raising set. Cows are in good shape and will come to feed. (28)
- **16** Choice Angus cows that are long bred to an Angus bull. Cows are one raising and one brand. They are 3-4 years old and in great shape. Don't miss this set of young Angus cows. (29)
- **2** Angus pair that will have calves at their side weighing 400 lbs out of an Angus bull. Cows are 5 years old and should be 3in1's on sale day. They will be bred back to an Angus bull. (30)
- **3** Angus or black white face cows that will be long bred to an Angus bull. Cows are 5 years old and in good shape. (31)
- **170** Young Angus or English baldie cows that will be medium to long bred to Hartzog Angus bulls. Cows are 3-5 years old. They will be sorted into uniform groups according to pregnancy and kind. If you are looking for a good set of young cows then take a look at these. (32)
- **8** Angus or black white face pair that will have Angus calves at their side. Cows are 5 years old and should be bred back to an Angus bull for 3in1 packages. They will come to feed. (33)
- **100** Angus and black white face cows that will be long bred to Hereford bulls to calve this fall. Cows are 3-5 years old and will be sorted into uniform groups for your liking. They are gentle and will come to feed.(34)
- **37** Second calf black & black white face cows that are one raising. Cows are long bred to Charolais bulls. There will be a few calves on the ground by sale day. Don't miss these! (35)
- **15** Second calf Red Angus and black motley face cows that will be long bred to Red Angus bulls with some being pairs by sale day. This is a one raising set. (36)
- **11** Second calf Charolais cross cows long bred to Red Angus bulls. These females are all one raising. Could have a few calves by sale day. (37)
- **5** Second calf Angus pair with Angus sired calves at their side and selling back as open for the bull of your choice. These are gentle and come to feed. (38)
- **2** Second calf Brangus pair with Angus sired calves at their side. Cows come to cake and are selling back as open. (39)
- **1** Black motley face cow coming with her second calf. This cow is long bred to a Charolais bull. (40)
- **6** Black white face and red white face heifers bred to a low birth weight Angus bull. These females are of Rocking Chair origin and will start calving the second week in September. Heifers are gentle, cake broke and will weigh approximately 1000 lbs. (41)

- **175** Open Tigerstripe heifers that will average 675 lbs. Heifers are current on all shots and are ocv. Heifers will be ideal for the bulls of your choice later this fall. They have been handled the right way and are very gentle. They will be sorted into uniform groups for your liking. (46)
- **5** Horned Hereford heifers that will average 1000 lbs and will be selling as long bred to low birth weight Angus bulls. Heifers are gentle and easy to handle. (47)
- **5** Black F-1 heifers that will average 850 lbs and will be exposed to a low birth weight Angus bull for a short time. Heifers will come to feed. (48)
- **10** Hereford pair that are 3-5 years old with Hereford or Tigerstripe calves at their side that will average 300 lbs. Cows are running back with a Gray Brahman bull and should be 3in1's by sale day. (49)
- **4** Black white face and red white face cows that will be long bred to an Angus bull. Cows are 3-4 years old. (50)
- **3** First calf Hereford pair that have Hereford calves at their side. Heifers will be selling back as open and are very gentle. Heifers all go back to Made Right bloodlines. (51)
- **2** Open Hereford heifers that will average 700 lbs. They are ocv, gentle and are ready for the bull. (52)
- **2** Open black motley face heifers that are out of Hereford cows and Black Limousin bull. Heifers will average 700 lbs and are ready for the bull. (53)
- **35** Choice one raising set of Charolais cross cows that will be long bred to Angus bulls. Cows are 3-4 years old and all carrying one brand. If you want a set of calf raisers then take a look at these. (54)
- **45** Fall calving Angus along with a few Angus plus cows that will be three years old up to solid mouth bred to registered Brahman bulls that go back to Hudgins bloodlines. Bulls were turned out December 1st so cows should start calving in September. Cows are gentle and will come to feed. They will be sorted according to age and kind. For pictures go to our website. - **14** Angus and black white face heifers that will be bred for fall calving. Heifers should start calving the middle of September for approximately 60 days. They are all bred to an easy calving Corriente bull. Heifers are raised out of Bradley Angus bull. 10 will be baldies and 4 are Angus. For pictures go to our website. (56)
- **6** First calf Angus pair that have been running back with a Brahman bull (goes back to Hudgins bloodlines) and may be 3in1's by sale day. (57)
- **5** Black white face or red white face pair that will have their first calf at their side out of an Angus bull. Cows have been left open for the bull of your choice. They will have matching eartags. (59)
- **4** First calf Angus pair that will have Angus calves at their side. They have been left open for the bull of your choice. Pairs will be gentle and come to feed. (60)
- **25** Angus cows that will calve starting in September out of Powell Ranch Hereford or 44 Farm Ranch Angus bull. 15 of the cows will be 5 years old and 10 will be 6 years old. They are all gentle and come to feed. (61)
- **12** Angus plus cows that will be long bred to Gordon Sauer Ranch Angus plus bulls. Cows will be solid mouth, gentle and come to feed. For pictures go to our website. (62)
- **20** Angus pair that have Angus sired calves at their side and running back with Angus bulls. Some will be 3in1's. Cows will be mostly second and third calf. They are gentle and come to feed. (63)
- **30** Young Angus and black baldie pair with calves at their side out of Hertzog Angus bulls. Pairs will be mostly second and third calf. Good set of young pairs. (64)

16 Hereford pair with F-1 Tigerstripe calves at their side. These cows are running back with Brahman bulls and should be 3in1's by sale day. Cows are 3-4 years old. (65)

- **23** Black and black white face pair with 300-400 lbs calves at their side. These cows have been running back with Angus and Charolais bulls and should be 3in1's by sale day. Cows are 6 years old. (66)
- **40** Angus cows coming 6 years old and bred to calve December to February to Angus and Charolais bulls. Cows are 1250 lbs and gentle. (67)
- **4** Open Angus heifers weighing 700 lbs. These females are gentle and come to feed. (68)
- **20** Fall calving cows bred to registered Angus bulls. These are all good solid mouth cows with a lot of life left in them. (69)
- **5** Open Brangus heifers that will weigh around 850 lbs. (70)
- **6** Young Brangus cows that are short bred to Angus bulls. Cows are 3 ½ years old. (71)
- **2** First calf Brangus and red baldie pair that have calves at their side out of Angus bulls and have been running back with an Angus bull and could be 3in1's by sale day. (72)
- **14** Registered Beefmaster heifers that are short to medium bred to Wagyu bulls. Papers will be furnished. (73)
- **15** Open heifers in which 11 will be Brangus and 4 will be bladies. Heifers will weigh 850 lbs. They are gentle and come to feed. (74)
- **30** Black baldie heifers (some will have a touch of ear) that will calve this fall in approximately a 75 day period out of low birth weight Red Angus and Black Angus bulls. Heifers will weigh 1000 lbs plus. They are all ocv and will be sorted into uniform groups according to type. (75)
- **8** Home raised Angus cows that are medium bred to registered Angus bulls. Cows are 5-7 years old. (76)

- **60** Head of Brangus heifers that will calve this fall in a 75 day period out of low birth weight Black Angus and Red Angus bulls. Heifers will weigh 1000 lbs plus. They are all ocv and will come to feed. Nice set of Brangus heifers. (77)
- **50** F-1 heifers in which 20 are Tigerstripe and 30 will be red baldie heifers. Heifers will be long bred to low birth weight Angus bulls to calve this fall. They will be sorted into uniform groups for your liking. (78)
- **26** Home raised Super Baldie heifers that are medium bred to low birth weight Rockin R Angus bulls. These females are 20 months old. Heifers are extremely gentle and come to feed. (79)
- **4** Brangus pair with Brangus calves at their side and running back with Brangus bulls. These females are 3-4 years old. (80)
- **7** Brangus cows 3-4 years old and long bred to Brangus bull. (81)
- **45** Angus plus pair with Brangus sired calves at their side. Cows are coming four year olds. They will come to feed and are a good young set. (82)
- **4** Open Angus heifers that are gentle and come to feed. (83)
- **60** Angus heifers that will be long bred for fall calving out of low birth weight Red Angus or Black Angus bulls. Heifers are ocv, come to feed and will weigh 1000-1050 lbs. They should calve in approximately a 75 day period.(84)
- **3** First calf Black F-1 pair that have Angus calves at their side that will average 250 lbs. Heifers are running back with an Angus bull and should be 3in1's by sale day. (85)
- **7** Red Angus Gert cross heifers that have had Red Angus bulls running with them since May15th. Heifers are all one raising, ocv and current on vaccinations. They are weighing 900-1000 lbs. One heifer is red with the balance being red baldies. (86)
- **20** Angus cows bred to calve this fall to horned Hereford bulls. These cows are coming 4 years old,gentle and will come to feed. (87)
