## **October Replacement Female Sale**

Bred Cows, Pairs, Bred and Open Heifers will be offered

- **10** Brangus and Angus plus pair with their second calf at their side. Calves are out of Clark Ranch Angus bulls and cows have been running back with the same bulls and should be 3in1's by sale day. All cows are ocv and current on vaccinations. (1)
- **30** Brangus and Angus plus cows coming with their second calves. These females are long bred to Clark Ranch Angus bulls. They will be a nice gentle set of young cows that will be sorted by type and kind. Cows are all ocv and current on shots. (2)
- **10** First calf Angus plus pair that are extremely gentle and come to cake. These heifers should be open to breed to the bull of your choice. (4)

**44** Super black baldie heifers that are long bred to Red Angus bulls. Heifers have a lot of age and will weigh 1050-1100 lbs. Heifers are gentle and will come to a feed wagon. These will make someone a good set of front pasture cows. (5)

- **40** First calf Angus pair that will have Angus calves at their side out of 44 Farms Ranch Angus bulls that were turned out May 5 to July 24 and should all be 3in1's. Cows all go back to 44 Farms also. All come to feed. A lot of good genetics in this set of pairs. (6)
- **15** Super Baldie heifers bred to start calving in December to Double Creek low birth weight Angus bulls. This is a one raising set of females. (7)
- **35** Black and black white face heifers bred to start calving in March to Double Creek Angus bulls. Heifers will be sorted into uniform groups. (8)
- **20** Young Angus or Angus baldie pairs that will have Hereford calves at their side. Cows are second or third calf and have been left open for the bulls of your choice. They will have matching eartags and be current on all shots. Pairs are gentle and will be sorted into uniform groups. (10)
- **15** First or Second calf home raised Angus pair that have a choice set of Angus calves at their side. Cows have been exposed back to an Angus bull for a short time. Cows are gentle and easy to handle. (11)
- **25** Brangus & Brangus white face heifers that will be selling as long bred to proven low birth weight Angus bulls. Heifers are easy to handle and will come to feed. All heifers are current on shots and have been wormed. (12)
- **13** Open Black F-1 females out of JD Hudgins Brahman bulls and registered Black Angus cows. These females are 13 months old and were weaned at 8 months. Heifers have had 2 rounds of shots and are extremely gentle. (13)

**75** One raising set of Hereford heifers that are medium to long bred to solid Black Corriente bulls for easy calving. These females are all ocv and gentle. Heifers will weigh 1000 lbs plus. This is a good set of Hereford heifers that will fit any program. (14)

- **60** Young Angus or Angus baldie cows that will be medium to long bred to Hereford bulls. Cows will be second or third calf and go back to northern genetics. They are current on all shots and will make a great set of calf raisers. Don't miss this group that will be sorted into uniform groups for your liking. (15)
- **19** Red Angus heifers that will be long bred to Red Angus bulls. Heifers will weigh 1000 lbs plus and come to cake. Gentle set. (16)
- **11** Red baldie (Red Angus cross) heifers that are long bred to Red Angus bulls. Heifers will weigh 1025-1075. They all come to cake. (17)

**90** Choice open Red Angus heifers that are all one raising and go back to some good northern genetics and were born and raised in Texas. Heifers will not be carrying any brands or earmarks. They are all ocv and will weigh 850-875 lbs. For pics go to our website. (17a)

- **30** Young Brangus and Brangus baldie cows that will be medium bred to Angus or Brangus bulls. Cows are 3-5 years old and will be sorted into uniform groups according to kind. Cows will come to feed and current on all shots. (18)
- **45** Angus pair that will have Angus or Charolais calves at their side. Cows are 3-5 years old and have been running back with same bulls and could be 3in1's. (19)
- **45** Angus or Angus baldie cows that will be medium to long bred to Angus or Charolais bulls. Cows will be 3-5 years old and will be sorted into uniform groups according to kind. (20)
- **7** Angus pair that will have Charolais cross calves at their side that will weigh 275-400 lbs. Cows are 4-5 years old and have been running back with a Charolais bull and could be 3in1's by sale day. (21)
- **5** Angus cows that will be 3-5 months bred to a Charolais bull. Cows are 4-5 years old and will come to feed. Cows will be in good shape. (22)
- **70** Heifers which 50 are Brangus and 25 are Brangus baldies. Heifers will be long bred to Angus, Red Angus or Brangus bulls. All the bulls are registered and low birth weight. Heifers will weigh 950-1000 lbs. They will be sorted into uniform groups by kind. Don't miss this set of productive females. (23)
- **25** Angus plus heifers that will be long bred to Angus, Brangus or Red Angus bulls. The bulls will be registered and low birth weight. Heifers will weigh 950 lbs. (24)
- **8** Fancy True F-1 Tigerstripe heifers that are out of a Hudgins Brahman bull and Hereford cows. Heifers are home raised off Lamar Johanson in Goldthwiate. They will weigh 700 lbs and be gentle and come to feed. Heifers are ocv. (26)
- **1** True F-1 heifer that is out of a Hudgins Brahman bull and a Hereford cow and she will be solid red in color. Heifer will weigh 700 lbs and is a ½ sister to the ones above and will be ocv. (27)

**43** Red Angus heifers that are Ai'd to a registered Red Angus bull LSF SRR Commander 5906C and cleaned up with a registered Red Angus bulls (2 sons of Brown Pacesetter Y7170 and 1 son of Brown Epic A7523) in which all are low birth weight and in the top percent of calving ease. Heifers will weigh 900-950 lbs and are current on all shots and will come to feed. If you are looking for a good set of Red Angus heifers then take a look at these. Heifers were Ai'd on 4-13-16 and clean up bulls were turned in on 4-23-18. (28)

- **5** Angus or Angus cross heifers that will be medium bred to a registered Red Angus bull. Heifers will weigh 900-950 lbs. (29)
- **7** Black or black motley face cows that will be medium bred to an Angus bull. Cows will be second calf and will come to feed. (30)
- **7** Black or black motley face heifers that will be medium to long bred to an Angus bull. Heifers are home raised and will weigh 900 lbs. (31)
- **19** Home raised exposed heifers which 14 are black motley face and 4 are black and 1 red motley face that are out of Hereford bulls and Angus cows. Heifers will weigh 800-850 lbs and have been exposed to a Domel Angus bull for 45 days. They will be selling as exposed. Heifers will be sorted into uniform groups according to kind. (32)
- **10** Angus heifers that will start calving in December out of solid Black Corriente bulls. Bulls were turned out March 15<sup>th</sup>. They are all one raising. (33)
- **15** Angus cows that will be medium bred to a polled Hereford bull. Bulls were turned in last April. Cows are solid mouth and will come to feed. (34)
- **3** Open Red Angus heifers that will weigh 1000 lbs. Heifers are 2 years old and ocv. (35)
- **59** Angus cows that all go back to good northern genetics. Twelve cows will have calves at their side and the other 47 will be medium to long bred to gentle, good tempered Solid Homozygous Black Limousin bulls. Cows will come to feed, will be solid mouth and pairs will be sold separately from the bred. (36)
- **5** One raising set of open Brangus heifers that will average 800 lbs. Heifers are ideal for the bull of your choice this fall. Heifers are all ocv and current on all shots. (37)
- **6** Home raised Beefmaster cows that are straight 5 years old set that will be selling as medium to long bred to Angus bulls. Cows are in good flesh and easy to work. (38)
- **20** Angus & Angus plus pair that are 2-3 years old with a choice set of calves at their side out of Angus or Charolais bulls. Cows are gentle and will be selling back as open. Cows are home raised. (39)
- **4** Charolais Cross pair that are 5 years old with Angus cross calves at their side. Cows are selling back as open and very gentle. Cows are home raised. (40)
- **4** Angus heifers that will be selling as medium bred to a low birth weight Angus bull. Heifers are home raised and gentle. (41)

**36** Choice first calf Angus plus pair that are in excellent shape with Angus calves at their side. Pairs are gentle and come to feed and will be selling back as open for the bull of your choice. - **3** Beefmaster heifers that will be selling as medium bred to a proven low birth weight Angus bull. Heifers are very gentle and are the calf raising kind. (43)

- **4** black and black motley face heifers that will be selling as medium to long bred to a proven low birth weight Angus bull. Heifers are easy to handle. (44)
- **15** Open one raising set of Chi Angus heifers that will average 800 lbs. Heifers are cake broke and are all ocv. Heifers will be current on all shots and are ready for the bull of your choice. (45)
- **40** Open Brangus heifers that will average 700 lbs and will be ideal for the bulls of your choice this fall. They are current on all vaccinations and ocv. (46)
- **5** Open Brahman heifers that will average 750 lbs. Heifers are ocv and ready for the bull of your choice.(47)

- **7** Open True F-1 heifers that are all one raising weighing 600-650 lbs. Heifers will not be carrying any brands or earmaks. For pictures go to our website. (53)
- **10** One raising set of black white face and red white face heifers weighing 1000 lbs plus bred to solid Black Corriente bulls. These females are all ocv and will be sorted into uniform groups. (54)
- **15** Angus and Angus plus heifers weighing 1000 lbs plus that are medium to long bred to sleep easy solid Black Corriente bulls. Heifers are all ocv and come to cake. (55)
- **2** Brangus cows medium to long bred to a registered Danny Reeh Brangus bull. These cows are middle aged and big and stout. They are extremely gentle and come to feed. (56)
- **15** Open one raising set of Brangus heifers that will have a light end of 550-650 lbs and the heavy end will weigh 750-800 lbs. Heifers are extremely gentle and come to feed and will be sorted into uniform groups.(57)
- **100** Angus plus and Brangus heifers bred to Wagyu bulls for easy calving. These females will be medium to long bred and have been running in South Texas. Heifers will be able to go anywhere and do great. They will make a nice set of momma cows that should calve out easily. These females are current on all shots. (58)
- **50** Open Tigerstripe heifers that will average 675 lbs. Heifers have been hand selected and are easy to handle. Heifers are current on all shots and are ocv. (59)
- **50** Angus heifers long bred to low birth weight Clark Ranch Angus bulls. These will be a big stout set of females that are bred to proven set of bulls. These should be a choice set! (60)
- **20** Half blood Brahman cross heifers bred to proven low birth weight Brangus and Angus bulls from Triple Son. These females should be long bred and about half will black and black motley face with the balance being colored. These females will be sorted by color. These will make a nice set that will last a lifetime.(61)
- **15** SimAngus heifers weighing 1100 lbs and long bred to Evans Ranch Angus bull. These gentle females are all ocv and come to feed. Heifer are current on shots. (62)
- **2** SimAngus first calf pair with Angus sired calves at their side. Cows are open to breed to the bull of your choice.(63)
- **10** Black and black motley face cows that are coming 4 years old and short bred to a Brangus bull. (64)
- **12** One raising Angus plus heifers long bred to a low birth weight Brangus bull. These heifers will weigh 1100 lbs and are gentle and all ocv. (65)
- **3** Angus plus cows medium bred to a Wagyu bull. These females are 5-6 years old. (66)
- **40** Black and black white face cows 5-7 years old. Cows will be short to long bred to registered Angus bulls. They will be sorted by age and pregnancy. (67)
- **24** Angus cows long bred to Angus and Hereford bulls. These cows should be 5-6 years old. They have been wormed and given Lepto-Virbrio and a Multimin shot. (68)
- **40** Open Angus heifers weighing 700-750 lbs. These females are all out of registered parents but do not carry papers. Heifers are up to date on vaccinations and are all ocv. This will be a nice set of open heifers. (69)

<p><b>40</b> Choice Brangus heifers that will be long bred to Polled Hereford bulls. Heifers are gentle and come to feed and will weigh 1000-1100 lbs. These will make a nice set of momma cows. (70)</p>

- **25** Choice second calf Santa Gertrudis cows that will be long bred to Hereford bulls. A few will have calves at their side by sale day. Cows are all one raising. Not many of these around! (71)
- **6** Choice Braford heifers that will be long bred to low birth weight Black Angus bulls. Heifers are big and good. (72)

- **10** Second calf Angus plus pair that will have calves at their side out of Sauer Ranch Angus plus bulls. Pairs will be selling back as open for the bull of your choice. (73)
- **10** Second calf Angus plus pair that will have calves at their side out of Sauer Ranch Angus plus bulls. Pairs will be selling back as open for the bull of your choice. (73)
- **45** Angus or Brangus cows with some red or Charolais crosses that will be medium to long bred to Angus bulls. Cows are 4-6 years old and will be sorted into uniform groups according to the kind and pregnancy. (74)
- **14** Angus pair that are 5-6 years old with 250 lbs calves at their side out of Tarentaise bulls. Cows are exposed back to an Angus bull. (75)
- **25** Angus cows medium to long bred to a Hat Ranch Tarentaise bull. Cows are 5-6 years old. Good set of females. (76)
- **127** Brangus and Angus plus heifers long bred to low birth weight Angus bulls. Heifers will weigh 950-1000 lbs. They were all ear tagged and wormed on October 5<sup>th</sup> with Dectomax Pour On. These females will be sorted into uniform groups by type and kind. (78)
- **3** Brangus first calf pair with Angus sired calves at their side and exposed back to an Angus bull. (79)
- **50** Brangus and Angus plus cows bred to start calving in November to Angus and Hereford bulls. Cows are coming with their third calf. (80)
- **53** Brangus and Angus plus pair with Angus sired calves at their side and bred back to Angus bulls. Cows are third calf cows and should be 3in1's by sale day. (81)
- **37** Brangus and Angus plus pair with Angus sired calves at their side. Cows have been running with Hereford bulls and should be 3in1's. (82)
- **10** Angus plus heifers that will be medium bred to Angus bulls. (83)
- **45** Angus and Angus plus cows that had Angus bulls out in April and taken out in August with most being 5-7 months bred. Cows will be second calf on up to solid mouth. They will be sorted into uniform groups. (84)
- **10** Open Brangus and Angus plus heifers that are all home raised. Gentle set and will weigh 700-750 lbs. For pictures go to our website. (85)
- **2** Gray Brahman cows 3-4 years old exposed to a Hereford bull. (86)
- **6** Tigerstripe pair with 44 Farms calves at their side. Cows should be open for the bull of your choice. (87)
- **35** Brangus cows medium bred to Lone Sar Ranch Hereford bulls. Cows will be solid mouth. (88)
- **40** Young Angus along with a few Black F-1's and Tigerstripe F-1's that will be medium bred to low birth weight Brahman bulls. Cows will be sorted into uniform groups. (89)
- **5** Angus cows AI bred to a registered Brangus bull. Cows will be medium bred. (90)

**50** One raising set of 3 year old Brangus cows that will be coming up with their second calf out of Express Ranch Angus bulls. Cows will start calving around January thru March. (91)

- **25** Brangus type cows that will be medium to long bred to Angus or Hereford bulls. Cows are 3-5 years old and will come to feed. They will be sorted into uniform groups according to pregnancy. (92)
- **29** Open Red Angus heifers weighing 900 lbs. Heifers are a one raising set and they are current on all vaccinations & ocv. (93)
- **40** Crossbred heifers weighing 1000 lbs bred to low birth weight registered Angus bulls. Heifers were pelvic measured prior to breeding, current on all vaccinations and ocv. (94)
