**MASON & SAN SABA** – Receipts totaled 1,146 head. A large amount of rain has continued to fall across Texas reducing the movement of cattle across the state. The stocker steers and heifers continued steady. The yearling steers and heifers all sold steady. Packer cows and bulls all sold \$2-\$3 higher. Not enough pairs and bred cows were on hand to test the market.
