Thursday, May 30, 2019

SAN SABA – Receipts totaled 1,322 head with no sale being held in Mason on Memorial Day. A good buyer attendance was on hand with stocker steers and heifers that had condition (thin and dried out) sold steady and in good demand. The real fleshy 500-900 lbs calves sold \$5 to \$10 lower. Feeder steers were \$5 lower with 3 at 638 lbs at \$152.00 (\$969.76) and feeder heifers were \$3 to \$5 lower. The fat cattle market has continued to move downward the last several weeks and corn has taken a big jump in price due to extreme wet conditions therefore increasing cost of gain. Normally about 94% is planted by now but only about 58% is estimated to be in the ground. This can change if there are a few weeks to dry out. Packer cows and bulls all sold steady. Pairs and bred cows were very active in some instances of \$50 to \$100 higher.
