**MASON** – Receipts totaled 512 head with reduced receipts due to the good 2 to 4 inch rain that fell in the area. The market opened the week with a more aggressive tone on most calves and yearlings. Stocker steers and heifers both sold steady to \$5 higher with 8 steers 599 lbs at \$150.00 (\$898.50). Feeder steers and heifers also sold steady to \$3 higher with 11 steers 717 lbs at \$135.00 (\$970.10). Packer bulls sold \$2 higher and cows sold \$1 higher. Replacement cattle sold steady.
