MASON & SAN SABA – Receipts totaled 1,730 head with some good rain falling over the area this week. The beginning of the week started out with a steady tone but corn continued to move higher (increasing cost of gain) with estimated yield and overall production being less due to the wet spring in the Cornbelt. The stocker steers and heifers with condition sold steady. The fleshy new crop calves weighing 500-800 lbs were \$5-\$7 lower. The feeder steers and heifers were \$5 lower. Packer cows were \$1-\$2 lower and bulls were \$2 lower. Bred cows and pairs were steady with good demand.
