SAN SABA – Receipts were reduced to 279 head due to the ice, snow, and rain over the area. Also, no sale was held in Mason due to the Holiday schedule. Stocker steers and heifers sold steady on a limited test. The feeder steers and heifers sold steady also on a limited test. Packer cows were \$3 to \$4 higher. No test on the packer bulls, pairs, or bred cows. One set of 4 Brahman heifers at 449 lbs brought \$225.00 (\$1,010.25).
