



Texas Animal Health Commission Breeder's Certificate of Virgin Status

Texas animals individually identified with an official identification described below are registered breeding virgin male bovine under 18 months of age **or** are males between 18 and 30 months of age and the breeder's veterinarian certifies that the breeder has sufficient management practices and facilities to ensure animals are virgins (veterinarian signature required). Only registered breeding bulls can be certified as virgin. Texas does not accept out-of-state virgin bulls; therefore all out-of-state bulls 12 months of age and older require a negative Trichomoniasis test to enter Texas.

The certification by the breeder is valid for sixty (60) days and may be transferred within that timeframe with an original signature of the consignor if there is no contact between the bull(s) and female cattle.
