**MASON & SAN SABA** – Receipts totaled 1,889 head. The market on Monday was steady with last weeks increases but as the week progressed the futures market continued to move lower reducing some of the gains in prices from the previous week. Stocker steers and heifers sold \$5-\$10 lower. Feeder steers were \$5-\$10 lower and heifers were \$10 lower. The fat grain field calves or fleshy new crop calves sold \$15-\$20 lower. Packer cows were \$7-\$12 lower and bulls were \$5-\$7 lower. Pairs and bred cows were active with very good demand.
