The stocker steers were \$10 higher with 16 steers at 569 lbs \$152.00 (\$864.88) and 23 steers at 439 lbs \$163.00 (\$715.57). The stocker heifers were \$5 higher. Feeder steers were \$5-\$7 higher with 11 steers at 649 lbs \$154.00 (\$999.46) and feeder heifers were \$2-\$3 higher. Packer cows were \$5 higher and bulls were \$3 higher. Pairs and bred cows were steady to \$100 higher.
