- **120** Angus or black motley face cows with a few Red Angus that will be long bred to good Horned Hereford bulls. Cows will be 3-5 years old and raise a choice set of calves. They will be sorted into uniform groups according to kind. Don't miss this set of productive females. (9)

- **10** Open purebred Gray Brahman heifers that will average 750 lbs. Heifers are gentle and easy to handle. They are all ocv and current on shots. (17)

- **20** Fancy open Brangus heifers weighing 850-900 lbs. They are one raising and ocv. Don't miss these!(18)
- **35** Open True F-1 heifers that are all raised on one ranch. There will be 12 True F-1 Tigerstripe that were raised out of Brahman (Hudgins) cows and Powell Ranch Hereford bulls. Heifers will not have any brands, are ocv and will weigh around 700 lbs. There will also be 21 open Black F-1's out of Brahman (Hudgins) cows and Donop or Griswold Angus bulls. Seven will be weighing around 625 and 16 will weigh around 875 lbs and will not be carrying any brands and are ocv. These heifers are raised on a reputation ranch.(19)
- **12** Open True F-1 heifers in which there will be 8 Tigerstripe and 4 red baldies. Heifers are all one raising and ocv. They are not carrying any brands or earmarks and will weigh around 700 lbs. (20)
- **40** Choice open Angus and black baldie heifers that are all one raising. Heifers are all ocv and will weigh 700-800 lbs. Ideal for the bull this fall or winter. Baldies will sell separate from the Angus. (21)
- **16** Fancy Hereford heifers that are all home raised and coming off Texas Stardance in Hamilton, TX. Heifers are 19-20 months old and will weigh 950 lbs and be ready for the bull of your choice. They will be out of registered stock but selling as commercial. Don't miss this set of choice Hereford heifers. (22)
- **21** Cows which sixteen are Angus and five Red Angus cows that will be medium bred to a choice Hereford bull from Texas Stardance. Cows will be 4-7 years old and will be the calf raising kind. They will be sorted by color into uniform groups. (23)

Complete Ranch Dispersal

97 Angus and black baldie (English) cows that will be medium bred to Angus bulls. Cows were all raised on the ranch. About half of the calves will be Angus and half baldies (out of W4 Ranch Hereford bulls). The Angus will sell separately from the baldies. This is a complete ranch dispersal. Approximately 70 of the cows will be 3-5 years old with the balance being solid mouth. All cows have the year of birth in their eartags. This will make a good set of ranch cows. (27)

- **68** Angus and black baldie heifers that are all one raising that will start calving at the end of December. Heifers are bred to solid black easy calving Longhorn bulls. Bulls are kept out for 120 days. Heifers will be pregnancy tested and sorted into uniform lots. (28)
- **60** Hereford heifers that are all one raising and bred to start calving the end of December out of solid black Longhorn bulls. Bulls were out for 120 days. Heifers will be pregnancy tested and sorted into uniform groups. If you want a set that will make a good F-1 factory then take a look at these. (29)
- **250** Black, black white face, red white face and Hereford cows that are 3 years up to solid mouth. Cows are medium to long bred to Robert and Randy White Hereford bulls and McKenzie Angus bulls. Cows were vaccinated last December with Triangle 9+PHK, Lepto Vibrio and Trich Guard. Calves were weaned in September and steers weighed 650 lbs and heifers 638 lbs. They are gentle and will be sorted into uniform lots. (30)
- **30** Angus plus cows that are 4-5 years old and are medium to long bred to Hereford, Angus or Brangus bulls. Cows will weigh 1150-1200 lbs and are current on vaccinations and worming. They are gentle and will come to feed. (31)
- **45** One iron set of cows that will be black motley face and red motley face that are all English based. Cows will be medium bred to Horned Hereford bulls to calve in the spring. They will be 5-8 years old and the only reason they are selling is due to dry conditions out west. (32)
- **15** Hereford cows which five will have calves at their side out of Brahman bulls and the balance will be long bred to the same bulls. Cows will be 3-5 years old and will fit your F-1 program. (33)
- **8** Young Brahman cows that will long bred to a Hereford or Angus bull. Cows will be 3-5 years old and be in good shape. They are made right and will be choice. (34)
- **17** Angus or Angus plus cows with a few Charolais cross that will be long bred to Angus or Hereford bulls. Cows will be 4-6 years old and will be sorted into uniform lots according to kind. (35)
- **28** Angus cows that will be long bred to Angus bulls. Cows are 3-5 years old and will be good calf raisers. They will come to feed. (36)
- **4** Black pair that will have calves at their side out of Means Ranch Angus bulls. Cows are out of Angus bulls and cows that are out of Tigerstripe cows and Angus bulls. They have been running back with an Angus bull and should be 3in1's. Cows are 2-3 years old and will be gentle. They are all home raised. (37)
- **3** Home raised heifers that are out of Means Ranch Angus bulls and black motley face cows (Tigerstripe/Angus cross). Heifers will weigh 800 lbs and be ready for the bull in December. (38)

- **10** Home raised Hereford heifers that will weigh 700-800 lbs. Heifers have been exposed to an Angus bull 2 months ago and they will be palpated. They are gentle and will come to feed. (39)
- **30** Middle aged cows in which 19 are Hereford and 11 are Angus bred to start calving in February to registered Hudgins Gray Brahman bulls. These cows will be in good condition and will come to feed. (40)
- **40** Charolais cross heifers that are medium bred to low birth weight Red Angus bulls. These females are big framed and will have a touch of ear. (41)
- **12** Charolais cross cows that will be 3-5 years old with a touch of ear. These cows are medium bred to Charolais cross bulls. (42)
- **12** Open SimAngus heifers sired by RA Brown bulls. These black and black motley face heifers are one year old and will weigh 700 lbs. Heifers will be ready to breed in December. (43)
- **3** Registered Red Angus heifers weighing 850-900 lbs. These open females are all 18 months old and are ready to breed this fall. Papers will be available and will transfer at buyer's expense. (44)
- **60** Cows which 50 will be Angus or Brangus type and 10 will be Red or Charolais cross. Cows will be bred to Charolais bulls. 40 will calve before the end of the year and 20 will be spring calving. Cows will be 4-6 years old and will be sorted into uniform groups according to kind. (45)
- **15** Angus and Angus plus heifers that will be medium bred to a low birth weight Angus bull to calve this spring. The bull is a son of Broken Row. Heifers will weigh 950 lbs and are all home raised. (46)
- **8** Angus cows that will be medium bred to an Angus bull. Cows will be 4-6 years old. (47)
- **75** Cows which 55 are Beefmaster/Angus cross and 20 will be Beefmaster. Cows will be medium to long bred to Beefmaster bulls and there will be some calves by sale day. Cows will be 3 years old to solid mouth. They will be sorted into uniform groups according to kind, pregnancy and age. (48)
- **6** Black Angus heifers that will be medium bred to a black Corriente bull for easy calving. Heifers are a one raising set and originated off the Probst Farms in Brady. They are gentle and will come to cubes. (49)
- **200** Angus cows that will be medium bred to Express Ranch Angus bulls. Cows were all raised on the ranch and will be 3 years old up to solid mouth. Bulls were put in May for 90 days. Cows will be sorted up according to age. A lot of good genetics in this consignment of cows. (50)
- **20** Babytooth Angus cows that are 2-4 years old and will be selling as long bred to either Angus or Hereford bulls. Cows are in ideal condition and could have a few calves by sale day. (51)
- **2** Tigerstripe pair that are 3-5 years old and should be open to breed to the bull of your choice. (52)
- **5** Brangus cows that are medium to long bred to black bulls. Cows are 3-5 years old. (53)
- **6** Charolais cross cows that are 3-5 years old and long bred to black bulls. Could have some calves by sale day.(54)
- **6** Black white face and red white face second calf cows that are medium to long bred to black bulls. (55)
- **100** Angus and Angus plus pair with Santa Rosa Brangus and JD Hudgins Brahman sired calves at their side. Cows are running back with Charolais bulls and cows are baby tooth to solid mouth. Cows will be sorted by age and pregnancy. (56)
- **102** Angus and Angus plus cows that are baby tooth to solid mouth and short to long bred to Santa Rosa Brangus and JD Hudgins Brahman bulls. Cows will be sorted by age and pregnancy. (57)
- **26** Brangus heifers sired by JD Hudgins Brahman bulls and Santa Rosa Brangus bulls. These females are long bred to a low birth weight Angus bull. Some calves by sale day. (58)
- **20** Open Brangus heifers weighing 900 lbs. Heifers are sired by Santa Rosa Brangus & JD Hudgins Brahman bulls. These females are ready for the bulls. (59)
- **2** Young Angus pair with Angus calves at their side. Cows are open for the bull of your choice. (60)

- **2** Registered Angus heifers out of Evans Ten X bull that are medium bred to a son of Hoover Elation and a son of Connealy Blackhawk. Papers transferred at buyer's expense. (66)
- **80** Brangus and Angus plus pair with a few Braford pair that have a set of SimAngus calves at their side that will average 250 lbs. Cows are solid mouth and are running back with the same SimAngus bulls and should have several 3in1's by sale day. (67)

45 Angus and Angus plus cows that are 4 years old and moderate framed. Cows were AI bred on April 9th to high performance Gardiner Angus bulls and cleaned up with RA Brown Angus bulls. Cows are gentle and follow the feed truck. Cows have been given Vision 7 with Somnus, Virashield 6+VL5HB, Safeguard and Cydectin wormer. These will be nice. (68)

- **4** Brangus baldie cows that are 3 years old and short bred to a Red Angus bull. Cows are gentle and come to feed. (69)
- **2** Second calf Charolais cows that will be short bred. Cows were AI bred to a Maine Angus bull on August 6th and cleaned up with an Angus bull. Cows are gentle. (70)
- **8** One raising set of SimAngus heifers that will average 800 lbs and will be ideal for the bull of your choice this winter. Heifers are big boned and stout. (71)
- **3** Black white face heifers that will be selling as long bred to a Beefmaster bull. Heifers are gentle and will come to feed. (72)
- **2** Charolais cross heifers that will be selling as long bred to a Beefmaster bull. Heifers are gentle and will come to feed. (73)
- **10** Brangus heifers bred to a low birth weight Angus bull GAR Ingenuity K602 from April 1 through September 1. Heifers are out of registered Brangus ranch raised females and registered Brangus bulls MC Real Massive 98E and SRR Ranger 820C18. Heifers have completed the Vac 45 program. They are developed on range and in one contemporary group. They are not carrying any brands, easy to handle and respond well to a call. (74)
- **10** Angus heifers that will calve this spring to a calving ease low birth weight Horned Hereford bull. Heifers are gentle and easy to handle. (75)
- **40** Hereford cows short to medium bred to Powell Hereford bulls, Gardiner and SAV Angus bulls. Cows are middle aged and will be sorted into uniform lots. (76)
- **35** Black white face cows short to medium bred to Gardiner & SAV Angus bulls. Cows are solid mouth and will be sorted into uniform lots. (77)
- **2** Registered Gray Brahman cows bred to a registered Brahman bull owned by Red Smith Genetics and Herritage. Semen sales for over \$1200/straw. These cows are bred to calve this spring and will be nice.(78)
- **30** Angus cows that will be long bred to a choice Horned Hereford bulls. Cows will be 3-5 years old and will come to feed. (79)
- **21** Angus or Angus plus cows with some baldies which 11 will have calves at their side out of Angus or Charolais bulls and 10 will be long bred to Herford or Angus bulls. Cows are 3-6 years old. The pairs have been running back with Hereford and Angus or bulls and could be 3in1's. They will be sorted into uniform groups according to kind.(80)
- **8** Red Angus cows which 4 will have calves at their side and 4 will be long bred to a Hereford or Angus bull. Cows are 3-5 years old and the pairs could be 3in1's. (81)
- **12** Charolais cross cows that are 3-5 years old. Six will have calves at their side out of Charolais or Angus bulls and 6 will be long bred to Herford or Angus bulls.
- **4** Crossbred cows that will be long bred to an Angus or Hereford bull. Cows are 4-5 years old. (83)
- **30** Red and red white face heifers that have 15 calves at their side out of a Polled Hereford bull with the balance being long bred to the same Polled Hereford bull. Heifers are in good condition and are very gentle. Don't miss this set of calf raisers. (84)
