MASON & SAN SABA – Receipts totaled 7,049 head. The market this week moved a lot higher with a choice offering of cattle on hand. The 350-450 lbs steers sold \$10-\$15 higher with the balance of the stocker steers selling \$5-\$10 higher with 9 seters 507 lbs at \$172.00 (\$872.04). The 350 to 450 lbs heifers were \$10-\$15 higher with the balance of stocker heifers \$5-\$10 higher with 31 heifers 567 lbs \$137.00 (\$776.79). The feeder steers were \$3-\$5 higher with 14 steers 635 lbs at \$141.50 (\$898.53) and the feeder heifers were \$3-\$5 higher. The packer cows were \$2 higher and bulls were steady. The 30 Hales Ranch Angus bulls averaged \$4137 ranging from \$3100 to \$6250. The Charolais bulls averaged \$3438, the Brangus bulls averaged \$2375, and the Herefords averaged \$2820.
