MASON & SAN SABA – Receipts totaled 1,672 head. The market was steady on most classes of calves and yearlings. Stocker steers and heifers with ideal condition sold steady, while fleshy new crop calves sold \$2-\$5 lower. Feeder steers sold steady and heifers sold \$2 lower. Packer cows and bulls remain steady from last week. Pairs and bred cows also sold steady. The 3C 7 Angus bulls sold from \$2300 up to \$3100. The prairie Rose 8 Hereford bulls sold from \$2100 up to \$2700. The better end of the bulls carrying good flesh and coming 2 sold from \$1900 up to \$3450. Some of the young bulls and bulls carrying less flesh brought \$1050 up to \$1800.
