**MASON & SAN SABA** – Receipts totaled 2,669 head. The overall calf market was softer this week due to the lack of rain throughout Texas and Oklahoma for the wheat grazing and also the warm days and cool nights that have affected the health on some of the calves. The stocker steers were \$5 lower and stocker heifers were \$3 lower. Feeder steers and heifers were \$2 lower. The real fleshy steers, heifers and bull calves sold \$5-\$7 lower. Packer cows were \$1-\$2 lower and bulls were steady. Pairs and bred cows were steady and in good demand.
