MASON & SAN SABA – Receipts totaled 6,045 head. Demand was very good throughout the week with more areas getting some beneficial rain. Stocker steers sold \$5-\$10 higher this week with 3 steers 468 lbs at \$232.00 (\$1085.76) and stocker heifers were \$2-\$5 higher. Feeder steers were \$2-\$5 higher with 9 steers 730 lbs \$179.00 (\$1306.70) and feeder heifers were \$2-\$4 higher with 27 heifers 879 lbs at \$137.00 (\$1204.23). Packer cows and bulls were steady after last weeks increases. Pairs and bred cows were \$150 to \$200 higher.
