SAN SABA – Receipts totaled 980 head with no sale being held at Mason due to the Labor Day Holiday. The market continued upward with stocker steers \$5 higher and stocker heifers \$5-\$10 higher. Feeder steers were \$3 higher with 4 steers 700 lbs at \$188.00 (\$1316.00) and feeder heifers were \$5 higher with 25 heifers 606 lbs at \$168.00 (\$1018.08). Packer bulls were steady and cows were steady to \$2 lower. Pairs and bred cows were in good demand on a steady market.
