MASON & SAN SABA – Receipts totaled 1,208 head with numbers reduced due to good rain that fell in the area. The market continued strong this week with very good demand. The stocker steers were \$5-\$6 higher with 13 steers 603 lbs at \$238.00 (\$1435.14) and stocker heifers were steady. Feeder steers were \$2-\$4 higher with 5 steers 749 lbs at \$204.00 (\$1527.96). Feeder heifers were \$8-\$10 higher. Packer cows and bulls were steady. There were not enough pairs and bred cows to get a good test.
