The feeder steers were \$3-\$5 higher with 4 steers 763 lbs at \$225.00 (\$1716.75) and feeder heifers were \$5 higher with 4 heifers 836 lbs at \$193.00 (\$1613.48). Packer cows were \$3-\$4 higher and bulls were steady. Pairs and bred cows were very active on a steady market. We will not be having any sales on the week of July 4th and will start sales back again on the week of July 10th.
