- **12** Straight five year old Hereford cows that will be selling as long bred to an Angus bull. Cows are in excellent condition and gentle. (2)
- **12** Angus pair that are 3-5 years old and exposed back to Evans Farms registered Angus bulls. Cows are gentle and could be 3in1's by sale day. (3)
- **3** Fancy long aged first calf purebred Brangus pair that have been running back with a registered Ultra Black bull and should be 3in1's by sale day. (4)

If you are looking for a set of calf raisers that will last, you a long time then take a look at these! (7)
- **20** Home raised True F-1 Tigerstripe heifers that will be short to medium bred to low birth weight Red Angus bulls. Heifers weigh 1000 lbs and will come to feed. They will make a good set of momma cows that will last you a long time. (8)
- **65** Angus along with a few baldie heifers that will be long bred to low birth weight Angus bulls. Heifers are gentle and will come to feed. Baldies will sell separately from Angus. A few will be pairs. (9)
- **5** Red Angus heifers that will be medium to long bred to a low birth weight Red Angus bull. (10)
- **12** Choice Angus and Angus plus long bred heifers to a low birth weight Angus bull. Heifers are very gentle and will come to feed. Don't miss this set! (11)
- **10** One raising set of Brahman heifers that will be short to medium bred to a low birth weight Hereford bull. Heifers are 2 years past and will weigh 1000-1100 lbs. (12)
- **10** Red crossbred heifers that will be short to medium bred to a Charolais bull. Heifers are $\frac{3}{4}$ Brahman and weighing 1000-1100 lbs. (13)
- **16** First calf Angus plus pair with Angus calves at their side and have been running back with a Wagyu bull for 2 months. Several could be 3in1's. (14)

- **7** Young Super Baldie pair with Charolais sired calves at their side and running back with a registered Angus bull. Cows are gentle and will come to feed. (16)
- **30** Brangus cows that are 6-8 years old and will be selling as long bred to a registered Angus bull. Cows are all home raised and very gentle. (17)
- **12** Straight 3 year old one raising set of black white face cows. Cows will be selling as long bred to a registered Angus bull. Cows are gentle and easy to handle. (18)
- **10** Angus pair that are all home raised and will have Angus calves by their side. Cows are 4-7 years old and have been exposed back to the same angus bull and could be 3in1's on sale day. (19)
- **20** Angus cows that are 4-7 years old and selling as medium to long bred to Angus bulls. Cows are all ranch raised. (20)

- **14** Beefmaster Angus cross heifers that will be medium to long bred to low birth weight Red Angus bulls.(28)
- **50** Angus cows that are 5-7 years old and bred to Express Ranch Angus bulls. Cows are in the prime of their life and super gentle. They will make a nice set of ranch cows. (29)
- **31** Open Angus heifers weighing 700 lbs. This a one raising set of gentle females that are current on vaccinations.(30)
- **5** F-1 Tigerstripe heifers short bred to a low birth weight Angus bull. (31)
- **10** Gelbvieh cows that are 2-3 years old and medium to long bred to a Hereford or Beefmaster bull. Cows are gentle and will come to feed. (32)

- **45** Brangus heifers that are open and will average 750 lbs. Heifers are very gentle and will come to feed. They are in ideal condition and will be ready for the bulls of your choice. All heifers are current on shots and are ocv. (36)
- **50** Open Tigerstripe heifers that will average 700 lbs. Heifers are all ocv and will be ready for the bulls of your choice this fall. They have been handled the right way and are very gentle. (37)
- **17** Home raised open Angus heifers that will average 725 lbs. Heifers will be ready for the bull of your choice this fall. They are very gentle and will come to feed. Heifers have had 2 rounds of Triangle 5. (38)
- **6** Home raised True F-1 Tigerstripe heifers that will be selling as open. Heifers are ocv. (39)
- **9** Brahman heifers that are selling as open. Heifers are home raised and will be ocv. (40)
- **7** Open purebred Gray Brahman heifers that are home raised and will average 800 lbs. Heifers are very gentle and will eat out of your hand. They are current on all shots and are ready for the bull. (41)
- **1** Black white face heifer that is open and will average 750 lbs. She is home raised and very gentle. (41a)
- **2** Registered Hereford pair that will have calves at their side out of a registered polled Hereford bull. They are 3-4 years old and have been running back with a registered polled Hereford bull and could be 3in1's.(42)
- **2** Purebred Angus pair that will have black baldie calves at their side out of a registered polled Hereford bull. Cows are 7-8 years old and could be 3in1's. They are running back with a registered polled Hereford bull. (43)
- **4** First calf registered Brahman pair that will have Hereford calves on the ground. They have been exposed back to a Hereford bull and will weigh 1250 lbs. Papers will be furnished on sale day. (44)
- **16** Northern bred Angus cows that will be long bred to an Angus, Hereford or Charolais bull. Cows are 6 years old and are big and stout. They are gentle and will come to feed. (45)
- **40** Young Brangus pair along with some $\frac{3}{4}$ bloods that will have calves at their side out of Ultra Black and Brangus bulls and have been running back with the same bulls. Several will be 3in1's. Most of the cows are 4 year olds along with a few 3 and 5 year olds. Will be sorted and shaped into uniform groups. (46)
- **18** Open True F-1 heifers that are out of Hudgins bred Brahman cows and Stardance Ranch Hereford bulls. Heifers are all clean headed, gentle and will come to feed. All have been wormed, ocv, and 7Way. Heifers will be ready for the bulls this winter. (47)
- **40** Angus plus cows that are all solid mouth and medium to long bred to Mound Creek & Reeh Brangus bulls. Cows are gentle and one raising. (48)
- **19** One raising set of $\frac{3}{4}$ Angus $\frac{1}{4}$ Beefmaster heifers bred to low birth weight Angus bulls that were turned out on April 18 and taken out on July 18. All are ocv and came out of rough country. They are gentle, cake broke and horse broke. (49)
- **4** First and second calf $\frac{1}{2}$ blood pairs with Hereford sired calves at their side. Cows are gentle and open to breed to the bull of your choice. (50)
- **59** Choice one raising set of open Brangus heifers long aged and will breed up fast this December. (51)
- **7** Choice F-1 Tigerstripe cows that are 6 years old and are 4-8 months bred to an Ohlde registered Angus bull. Cows are big, stout and gentle. Could have some calves by sale day. (52)
- **85** Black and black white face cows that will be 3-5 years old and long bred to Angus and Charolais bulls. There will be a good many calves by sale day. (53)

50 Hereford heifers that are all one raising and will be medium to long bred to low birth weight Hereford bulls. These heifers are all coming off the well known Brite Ranch. They are all 2 year olds. (83)

60 Open Hereford heifers that are all one raising off the reputation Brite Ranch. Heifers will be ideal to put the bull in later this year. Not many of these around. (84)

- **20** Red Angus cows that will be bred to Red Angus bulls to start calving February 1st. Cows are 3-5 years old and in good shape. (85)
- **20** American Red cows which are ½ Red Angus ½ Santa Gertrudis and will be bred to Red Angus bulls. Cows are 3-5 years old. (86)
