Stocker steers sold steady to \$5 higher with 2 steers 395 lbs at \$318.00 (\$1256.10). Feeder steers and heifers both sold steady from last week. Packer cows sold \$2-\$3 higher while bulls remained steady. Pairs and bred cows also sold steady.
