- **10** Choice first calf Brangus and Super Baldie pair that have Angus sired calves at their side and will be selling back as open to breed to the bull of your choice. Gentle set. Baldies will sell separately from the Brangus. (1)
- **20** Angus cows that will be coming up with their second calf this fall out of Angus bulls. Cows are all one raising. Very gentle and will come to feed. (2)
- **12** Open Angus heifers that are all one raising and will be ideal for the bulls this winter. Very gentle set. (3)
- **45** Angus heifers that will calve this fall out of low birth weight RA Brown Ranch Red Angus bulls. Heifers will weigh around 1000 lbs plus. (4)
- **12** Fancy second calf pair that are ½ Angus ½ Gert with Gardiner sired calves on the ground that will weigh 300 lbs plus. They are a one raising set. Cows have been running with a choice Red Angus bull and should be 3in1's. They will come to feed. Don't miss this set. (5)
- **25** Brahman heifers that will be bred to calve this fall out of low birth weight Red Angus Composite bulls. Will make a good F-1 factory. (6)

75 One raising set of open black baldie heifers that will have a touch of ear (1/8th). Heifers all go back to Jorgensen Angus Ranch genetics. They are not carrying any brands and have had 2 rounds of IBR shots and Blackleg shots. Are all ocv and will weigh around 625 lbs. Heifers are coming from the reputation McFaddin Enterprise Ranch. (10)

- **2** Cows that will be long bred to a GKB registered polled Hereford bull. 1 Angus and 1 black baldie that are 5-6 years old. They are in great shape and will be gentle. (34)
- **3** Registered Beefmaster pair that will have calves at their side out of a registered Angus bull. Cows are 3-5 years old and papers will be available on sale day. Cows have been running back with a registered Angus bull and should be 3in1's. (35)
