MASON – Receipts totaled 538 head on Monday & 2,510 head for the week. The market opened the week with a strong demand on all classes of calves and yearlings. Stocker steers sold \$2-\$3 higher and stocker heifers sold steady. Feeder steers sold \$8-\$10 higher with 2 steers 775 lbs at \$252.00 (\$1953.00) and 1 steer 950 lbs at \$230.00 (\$2185.00). Feeder heifers sold steady to \$2-\$5 higher. Packer cows and bulls both sold steady from last week. Pairs and bred cows also sold steady on a limited test.
