The stocker steers sold \$4-\$6 higher with 2 steers 355 lbs at \$400.00 (\$1420.00) and stocker heifers were \$3-\$4 higher with 10 heifers 494 lbs at \$292.00 (\$1442.48). The feeder steers were steady to \$3 higher with 8 steers 940 lbs at \$224.00 (\$2105.60). Feeder heifers were steady to \$1 higher. Packer cows were \$2-\$3 higher and packer bulls were steady to \$1 higher. Pairs and bred cows were \$200-\$300 higher and in very strong demand.
