MASON – Receipts totaled 1,453 head. The market opened the week with a mostly steady to a softer tone on calves and yearlings. Light weight stocker steers & heifers sold \$5-\$8 lower while 400-600 lbs steers sold steady with 5 steers 538 at \$292.00 (\$1571.00) Stocker heifers sold \$5-\$10 lower. Feeder steers sold steady to \$2 lower with 2 steers 725 lbs at \$250.00 (\$1813.00). Feeder heifers sold \$5-\$12 lower. Packer cows and bulls both sold \$2-\$3 lower. Replacement cattle sold steady on a limited test.
