Stocker steers were \$15-\$20 higher and some \$30 higher. The stocker heifers were \$13-\$20 higher. The feeder steers were steady to \$4 higher and feeder heifers were steady. The packer cows were \$4-\$5 higher and packer bulls were steady. Bred cows were steady along with the pairs that were offered.
