MASON & SAN SABA – Receipts totaled 2,839 for the week. Due to much needed rain in the Texas panhandle & Oklahoma the market had a strong up trend. Packer cows and bulls remained steady while stocker steers were \$10-\$18 higher and stocker heifers were \$10-\$15 higher. Feeder steers were \$8-\$10 higher and feeder heifers were \$5-\$12 higher. 14 head of Cannon Charolais bulls averaged \$6521 and 18 head of Hales Angus bulls averaged \$6730. There were 40 Exotic cross steers weighing 933 lbs at \$229.00 (\$2136.57). There were 38 Angus cross steers weighing 693 lbs at \$242.00 (\$1677.06). The market looks to have a lot of promise in the near future.
