MASON & SAN SABA – Receipts totaled 1,957 head. The market continued its movement upward this week after the Christmas and New Year's break. The stocker steers were \$10-\$18 higher with 4 steers 378 lbs at \$392.00 (\$1481.76). The stocker heifers were \$5-\$12 higher with 4 heifers 391 lbs at \$377.50 (\$1476.03). The feeder steers were \$8-\$10 higher with 4 steers 624 lbs at \$290.00 (\$1809.60) and feeder heifers were \$5-\$8 higher with 4 heifers 754 lbs at \$227.00 (\$1711.58). The packer cows were \$5-\$8 higher and bulls were \$5-\$7 higher. Pairs and bred cows were steady.
