The stocker steers were steady except for the real light weights were \$3-\$5 higher with 14 steers 302 lbs at \$500.00 (\$1510.00) and 5 steers 563 lbs at \$347.00 (\$1953.61). The stocker heifers were steady with 6 heifers 494 lbs at \$335.00 (\$1654.90). The feeder steers and feeder heifers were steady. Pairs and bred cows were \$200 higher or more. The STS 9 Angus bulls avg \$7406, the Hickory Sand 18 Brangus bulls avg 6819, the Cobb-Knob 4 Angus bulls avg \$6125, and the Reich Ranch 21 Maine Angus bulls avg \$5595.
