Thursday, November 13, 2025

MASON & SAN SABA – Receipts totaled 2,391 head. The market at the beginning of the week started higher but by mid week we saw the futures board begin to weaken and go lower based on uncertainties in the cattle market regarding the price of beef. The stocker steers sold steady to \$10-\$15 lower with 3 steer 504 lbs at \$450.00 (\$2268.00) and stocker heifers sold steady to \$5-\$6 lower. The feeder steers sold steady to \$5 lower with 4 steers 759 lbs at \$315.00 (\$2390.85). The feeder heifers were \$6-\$8 lower after last weeks increases. Packer cows and bulls were steady and stocker cows were steady with no test on the pairs. The Barber Ranch Polled and Horned Hereford bulls averaged \$13,550.50 on 99 bulls ranging from \$7,500 up to \$57,500. The Express Ranch 39 Angus bulls averaged \$12,717.95 and ranged from \$9,000 up to \$18,000.
