The stocker steers were steady to \$5 higher with 4 steers 523 lbs at \$530.00 (\$2771.90). The stocker heifers were \$10 higher with 3 heifers 417 lbs at \$555.00 (\$2314.35). The feeder steers were \$5-\$8 higher and the feeder heifers were steady with 2 heifers 698 lbs at \$379.00 (\$2645.42). The packer bulls and packer cows were steady. Pairs and bred cows were steady to \$100 higher with very strong demand.
