**MASON & SAN SABA** – Receipts totaled 749 head for the week with lighter runs due to widespread rains across much of the trading region. Demand continued very good for the week and prices were active across all classes. Stocker steers were steady except the 400 – 500 lb. steers which were \$10 higher, with 2 steers 473 lbs at \$550 (\$2601/head) and 2 head 550 lbs at \$500 (\$2750/head). Stocker heifers were also steady with 4 head 498 lbs at \$505 (\$2514/head). Feeder steers and heifers were steady. Packer cows and bulls were steady. Pairs and bred cows were steady and in good demand given the recent rains.
