The stocker steers were steady and the stocker heifers were steady also. The feeder steers were \$3-\$4 higher with 9 head 753 lbs at \$387.00 (\$2914.11) and 4 head 775 lbs at \$377.50 (\$2925.63). The feeder heifers were \$5 higher with 2 heifers 733 lbs at \$356.00 (\$2609.48). The packer cows and bulls were steady. The pairs and bred cows were steady on a limited test.
