The lighter weight stocker steers sold steady with the heavier weight stocker steers bringing \$8-\$10 higher with 39 steers 566 lbs at \$488.00 (\$2762.08). The stocker heifers were steady. The feeder steers were \$4-\$5 higher with 8 steers 688 lbs at \$420.00 (\$2889.60). The feeder heifers were steady to \$3 higher. Packer cows and bulls were steady. Pairs and bred cows were steady and some open replacement heifers were in strong demand with 3 head 548 lbs at \$600.00 (\$3288.00).
