**MASON** – Receipts totaled 1,218 on Monday for a total of 4,646 head for the week. The market opened the week with a strong demand on all classes of calves and yearlings. Stocker steers sold \$10-\$15 higher with 4 steers 489 lbs at \$530.00 (\$2591.70). Stocker heifers sold \$10-\$12 higher. Feeder steers sold \$5-\$10 higher with 25 steers 625 lbs at \$443.00 (\$2768.75) and 6 steers 864 lbs at \$357.00 (\$3084.48). Feeder heifers sold \$5-\$7 higher with 9 heifers 698 lbs at \$370.00 (\$2582.60). Replacement heifers sold strong with 7 brangus heifers 626 lbs at \$480.00 (\$3004.80). Packer cows and bulls sold steady with no test on replacement cows.
